Earthquake

What do you do, when it happened to occur?

Earthquake is frequent in Japan. It's a terrible experience for one who meets to an earthquake at first time. However, if you behave properly, you can avoid a serious injury from it. If you are prepared for the earthquake, you and your family will be safe from it.

Safety First. Earthquake! Hide underneath a table or desk

- 1. If you feel shaking, hide underneath a table or desk.
- 2. If it is not possible, cover your head with a pillow or cushion.

Secure an exit. If you feel shaking, open the door or window ensuring escape routes.

Do not rush outside. Keep quite cool in big shaking and look around for safety.

Major tremors do not last longer than a minute. Do not rush outside until shaking has stopped. Or falling objects may injure you.

Prevent fire! It's cause of disaster. Safety first, then turn off all of sources of fire.

- 1. Get into a habit to turn off using gas appliance and gas stoves.
- 2. Turn the gas off at the main and plug off electric appliances.
- 3. Turn off the circuit breaker before evacuation. (If you evacuate your home leaving fallen electric appliances or iron on, a secondary disaster may occur.)

If a fire breaks out. Make sure your safety, then put off a fire,

- If a fire breaks out, put off a small fire by bucket water or a fire extinguisher at early stage.
 (Be prepared a fire extinguisher and triangular bucket at your home, and reserve water in the bath)
- 2. Shouting out fire and asking the neighbors to help. Try to extinguish a small fire with neighbors at early stage.

When you are outside. Don't walk along the alleyway, near concrete wall, cliff or riverside.

- 1. If you walk along a narrow alleyway or near wall, beware of falling or collapsed objects such as roofing tile or concrete wall not to be caught under them.
- 2. Beware of collapsing the ground near cliff or riverside because earthquake makes the ground weak.

When you evacuate to shelter. You should go on foot with minimum supplies

Be prepared emergency supplies. (The following picture shows emergency supplies)
