

Saitama Prefectural Technical Junior College?



Qualification and skill are strong supporters of your employment chance during job shortage. Shall we consider ourselves for the future and challenge to obtain qualification? "Saitama Prefectural Technical Junior College" gives you a chance to make your dream come true with cheap short term courses.

Q Can anyone enroll in this college?

It depends on course you wish to study. In this college, there are many students who can be divided into two: those seeking employment for their first time & those changing their occupations.

Is there an examination for enrollment?

A There is a simple test which foreign applicants can also manage well. You should not be afraid of challenging it.

Are there female students learning in this collage?

A Female students are very welcomed. Some curriculums capture women's interests.

Q How long are courses consisted of?

There are 2 year course, 1 year course and short course depending on your purposes.

How is class schedule programmed?

Classes are held from 8:45 to 15:55 on Monday to Friday (closed on public holidays). Students are off school 2 weeks for summer and winter vacation, respectively.



How much is tuition fee?

A The tuition fees for 2 year course and 1 year course are \frac{\pmathbf{1}18,800}{118,800} per a year. Plus, entrance examination costs \frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2,200}.

For the short course, there are no fees for tuition and entrance examination. However, students have to pay their own expenses for textbooks, training clothes and application fees of each qualification.

How can I apply for enrollment?

A Foreign nationals are required to submit all necessary documents to "Hello-Work" during application period (Two ID photos required).

When the application period open?

A For 2-year and 1-year courses, the period is 3 weeks starting from October 1st.

In case of the short course, however, students are applicable during 2 weeks after January 13th.

Please confirm the necessary documents beforehand.

What kinds of courses are there?


There are 3 courses available: 1) 2 year course for "Metalworking", focusing on welding process, metal plate and other themes of metal production. 2-A) 1 year course for "Electric Working course",



obtaining knowledge electricity and training usage of tools and construction method. 2-B) "Woodwork course", for those willing to become the topflight woodworkers who make furniture and other wood Short course, products. 3) "Building Management course" for 6 months, studying professional management for building and factory.

Where is the college located?

A There are 7 locations in Saitama – Ageo, Kawaguchi, Kawagoe, Hannou, Chichibu, Kumagaya, and Kasukabe.

So far, there are necessary fees when we dispose computer and CRT TV (cathode-ray tube). From 1st April, collection for liquid crystal TV, plasma TV and clothes dryer also require some costs. That means, due to the new collection transport and recycling, we have to pay fees to retailer for disposal, even though some items were used to be collected as oversized garbage.

Application form for Supplementary Income Payment will be sent out from the beginning of April

The Supplementary Income Payment has been officially established on 4th March. The following is the basic flow for how it is supplied to us: 1) Application form is delivered from a public office. 2) A citizen fills his/her account number of financial institution in the form and sends it back to the office with identification (e.g. a copy of passport). 3) The public office confirms the submitted documents and transfers the money to the specified account. Money transfer is the basic procedure. If you wish to receive it by cash, public offices can directly provide it at their offices, but this is done after all money transfer is

completed. Fujimi city, Fujimino city and Miyoshi town plan to distribute the application form in early April and start transferring the payment in the end of April. Newsletters for April issued by each public office explain about it more precisely. If you need more information, we suggest you to contact your nearest office or FICEC. Some people might get confused at filling in the form.
