Fujimi City will provide medical care subsidies for children up to the age of 3rd grade of junior high school.

• Medical expense subsidy program expanded.

Fujimi City has been providing subsidies to medical expenses incurred in outpatient and inpatient treatment for preschool children and medical expenses incurred in inpatient treatment for elementary school (1st-6th grade) students.

In October, Fujimi city will begin providing subsidies to medical expenses incurred in both outpatient and inpatient treatment for children up to the age of 3rd grade of junior high school.

Eligibility requirements:

- The Children who are living in Fujimi city
- Parent/guardian with children in elementary/junior high school
- 3 Children who are enrolled in the National Health Insurance or Social Insurance

The portion of the medical expenses that should be paid by the patient will be covered by this medical subsidy.

● How to apply

You have to pay the portion of the medical expenses that should be paid by the patient at hospital. In the following month, you must go to child-realing support section at city office or the branch to apply for this subsidy. You will be required to have the following documents: ①Designated subsidy application form ②Receipt ③ Medical Care Certificate for the Child ④ Health Insurance Card

After checking these required documents, Fujimi city will transfer the medical expenses to applicant's bank.

The amount of money paid for the subsidy will inform the applicant by postcard.

As you may know, eco-points are earned by buying energy-efficient digital TV sets. Do you know that you can exchange the eco-points TV terrestrial digital antenna installation? The Eco-point program is extended to this December. If you plan to purchase a new TV set, you should proactively take advantage program. The cost of terrestrial digital TV antenna installation varies depending on installation site. You should confirm the installation cost when you buy a DTV set.
