# Take medical check-ups your municipality carry out

Illness affects a person's health and he/her happiness secretly.

Prevention is important. Please receive the medical ckeck-up of the cities

Do you take a medical check-up every year? It is troublesome.

I don't know how to apply for it. Because of those reasons, there may be many people who have never taken medical check-ups. The people who don't have medical check-ups in their companies, self-employed workers and housewives tend to put off medical check-ups. Many people aged 40 and over often have health problems. Please take advantage of receiving the free or inexpensive medical check-ups municipalities carry out.

A lot of municipalities provide medical check-ups for people aged 40 and over. However, depending on municipalities check-ups are offered for people aged less than 40. You first answer questionnaires regarding medical examination and have your weight • height measurements, blood pressure, blood test, urine test, electrocardiogram, lung chest X-ray examinations examined in general medical check-ups. Moreover, check-ups of stomach cancer, colon cancer, uterus cancer, breast cancer and particular diseases are carried out. You are able to take those medical check-ups at hospitals designated by your city with inexpensive fees.

If you are eligible to take medical services, you will receive a notification from your local municipal office. The publicities of municipalities also inform about medical check-ups. If you have any questions, please make inquiries to your local health centers. Basically most municipalities carry out medical check-ups from June to November, not all the year round.

When your body condition is something wrong, you may be able go to a health center and ask about it depending on municipalities. If you do not know what kind of doctor should be consulted, it may wise to go there and take medical consultation.

On the other hand, you may not be willing to take check-ups by municipalities because of language and visa problems. Some support organizations for foreign nationals take place own medical check-ups in urban areas sometimes. They prepare interpreters to feel easy to ask and take consultation about visa-related procedures. Unless you have appropriate visa, you cannot belong to a public health insurance program and would spend a lot of money for medical care. You can be treated while illness is light through using various medical check-ups which are offered by municipalities and other organizations. (commented by Miho MAEDA)
